

ORDINANCE 002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE
DECLARING ITS INTENT TO JOIN AND BE ANNEXED BY
THE KING COUNTY RURAL LIBRARY DISTRICT AND
REQUESTING THAT A SPECIAL ELECTION BE HELD FOR
THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING THE ANNEXATION
PROPOSITION TO THE VOTERS OF WOODINVILLE.

Whereas, Section 35.02.130 Revised Code of
Washington authorizes submission of a ballot
proposition to the voters of the City of
Woodinville to authorize annexation of the City
by the King County Rural Library District to be
effective immediately upon the effective date of
incorporation of the City, and

Whereas, pursuant to Section 27.12.360
Revised Code of Washington annexation is
initiated by an Ordinance stating the City's
intent to join the District and finding that the
public interest will be served thereby, and

Whereas, if the District concurs in the
annexation, notification thereof shall be
transmitted to the King County Council which
shall then call a special election to be held in
the City at the time and in the manner provided
by Section 27.12.370 Revised Code of Washington,
and

Whereas, an emergency exists sufficient to
have this proposition placed upon the next
eligible election date in that it is essential
for the City to resolve the issue of Library
services available to the residents of
Woodinville, now, therefore

Be it ordained by the City Council of the
City of Woodinville as follows:

Section 1. Declaration of Intent and
Finding. The City of Woodinville hereby
initiates the process of potential annexation of
the City to the King County Rural Library
District by stating its intent to join the
Library District. After consideration of the
options for providing continued library service
to the City's residents, the City Council finds
that the public interest will best be served by
annexation to said District, effective

immediately upon the effective date of incorporation of the City.

Section 2. Request for Concurrence. The City Council hereby requests the Board of Trustees of the King County Rural Library District to concur in the proposed annexation of the City by the District. The City Manager is directed to provide the District any and all such documents as may be required and to take such action as may be required to facilitate and effect the annexation.

Section 3. Transmittal of Ordinance. The City Clerk is directed to transmit certified copies of this Ordinance to the State Librarian pursuant to RCW 27.12.360 and to the King County Rural Library District Board of Trustees, and if the Board of Trustees concurs in the annexation to take the further steps outlined in Chapter 27.12 RCW to place this question before the voters at a special election.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Woodinville City Council and publication, as required by law.
