ORDINANCE NO. 20

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, ADOPTING CERTAIN TRAFFIC
INFRACTIONS ESTABLISHED BY STATE STATUTES BY
REFERENCE; CONTAINING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE
AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville is a noncharter code city organized and existing under the provisions of Title 35A of the Revised Code of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the Woodinville City Council finds that this ordinance is in the interest of the public health, safety and welfare, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Traffic Infractions Adopted by Reference.

Section 2. Traffic Violations Bureau Established.

- A. There is established a Violations Bureau as permitted by RCW 3.30.090, to assist in processing traffic cases and such other specific offenses under city ordinances as may be designated by written order of the _____ Division of the King County District Court, and this

Violations Bureau shall have the authority and responsibility authorized and specified by RCW 3.30.090, as it now exists, and as it may hereafter be amended.

- B. All fines or forfeitures collected upon conviction or upon the forfeiture of bail of any person charged with a violation of any of the provisions of this chapter shall be paid into the General Fund of the city.
- C. Failure, refusal, or neglect on the part of any judicial or other officer or employee receiving or having custody of any such fine or forfeiture of bail, either before or after a deposit in the general fund, to comply with the provisions of subsection (B) shall constitute misconduct in office, and shall be grounds for removal therefrom, provided appropriate removal action is taken pursuant to State law relating to removal of public officials.

Section 3. Enforcement.

- A. It shall be the duty of the officers of the Police Department, or such officers as are authorized to provide police services to the City, to enforce this title.
- B. Officers of the Police Department, or such officers as are authorized to provide police services to the City, are hereby authorized to direct all traffic by voice, hand, or signal in conformance with traffic laws; provided, that in the event of a fire or other emergency or to expedite traffic or to safeguard pedestrians, such

officers may direct traffic as conditions may require notwithstanding the provisions of the traffic laws.

Section 4. Penalty. Unless another penalty is expressly provided by law, any person found to have committed an act which violates the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a traffic infraction and shall be punished by a penalty of not more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00).

Section 5. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.


