ORDINANCE NO. 40

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO EMERGENCY SERVICES; AUTHORIZING APPOINTMENT OF A DIRECTOR OF EMERGENCY SERVICES; SPECIFYING THE DUTIES OF THE DIRECTOR; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, RCW 38.52 requires the City to provide for an emergency management organization, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Director--Appointment. A director of emergency services shall be appointed by the City Manager upon the basis of ability and training.

Section 2. Duties. It shall be the duty of the Director to create and maintain a basic emergency plan for man-made and natural disasters that may take place within the City pursuant to RCW 38.52. In addition, the Director shall:

1. Prepare an emergency operating plan for the city conforming to the county and state emergency plan and program;
2. Be responsible for the organization, administration and operation of emergency services as set forth in RCW 38.52.
3. Act as liaison officer between the city and county, state and federal offices of emergency services or civil defense;
4. Coordinate mutual aid and automatic aid agreements with neighboring municipalities;

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5. Control and direct the effort of the emergency operations organization of this city for the accomplishment of the emergency plan and its mission for the safety and well-being of the city and its inhabitants.

Section 3. Emergency Operation Staff. The Director and staff shall function under the direction of the City Manager in accordance with RCW 35A.13.080 and RCW 35A.13.090; provided, however, that only during such time of civil emergency as there may be in effect a proclamation issued by the Mayor, pursuant to RCW 35A.13.030, the Director and staff shall function under the direction of the Mayor in accordance with the emergency plan.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance shall be effective as of March 31, 1993, which is more than five (5) days after publication of an approved summary consisting of the title to this ordinance.


