ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING BY REFERENCE PORTIONS OF THE KING COUNTY CODE RELATING TO ROAD STANDARDS, SUBDIVISIONS, LAND USE AND HEALTH REGULATIONS DURING THE TRANSITION PERIOD.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville will incorporate on March 31, 1993, and

WHEREAS, at the time of incorporation King County will have on file permit applications which have been filed prior to incorporation but which have not been finally approved at the time of incorporation, and

WHEREAS, the City has entered into an interlocal agreement with King County authorizing King County to continue to process these permits under existing County codes, and

WHEREAS, persons desiring to apply for various governmental permits after incorporation will apply to the City of Woodinville under duly adopted Woodinville ordinances, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adopt relevant King County codes in order to allow King County to continue to process permits which have previously been filed with the County prior to incorporation,

WHEREAS, adoption of these various King County codes is a transition measure only and will only apply to those permits specified in this ordinance, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. County Codes Adopted. The following portions

Section 2. Transition. The portions of the King County Code adopted herein by this reference shall apply to those permits which have been filed with the County prior to March 31, 1993, and which are being processed by the County pursuant to the interlocal agreement between the City and King County as authorized by Resolution No. 93-21. The provisions of the King County Code adopted herein shall have no effect with respect to permits that are filed with the City subsequent to March 31, 1993.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 4. Effective Date. The City Council finds that the City of Woodinville will be incorporated on March 31, 1993. Failure to have the regulations contained in this ordinance in existence as of the date of incorporation will mean that the subject matter of this ordinance will be unregulated and thus will cause substantial detriment to the public health, safety and general welfare. The City Council therefore declares that an emergency exists necessitating that this ordinance be in full force in effect on March 31, 1993. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the City's official newspaper.


PASSED by a majority of not less than five members of the City Council of the City of Woodinville this 29th day of March, 1993.

Section 5. Termination Date. Unless otherwise provided by law, this ordinance shall terminate as of December 31, 1994.


