ORDINANCE NO. 56

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 46 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON MARCH 29, 1993, AND REVISING FEES FOR TEMPORARY FIREWORKS STAND AND THE HOURLY FEE FOR PERSONNEL.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend the fees for temporary fireworks stands and the hourly fee for personnel for certain review of hazardous materials management plans, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section N.3 of Exhibit A of Ordinance No. 46 is hereby amended to establish the annual inspection fee for temporary sales and public display of fireworks at \$100.00.

Section 2. Sections CCC, DDD and EEE of Exhibit A to Ordinance No. 46 are hereby amended to establish a regular hourly fee of \$35.00 for fireworks department personnel. The \$35.00 an hour fee for these items is for personnel performing work during regular work hours. Any overtime required because of the applicant's desire or rates charged by any consultant to the City shall be paid by the applicant.

Section 3. A revised Exhibit A to Ordinance No. 46 with the above changes is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.
