ORDINANCE NO. 58

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, REQUIRING ALL UTILITY EXTENSIONS
TO BE UNDERGROUND; AND ESTABLISHING AN
EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville is a noncharter code city organized and existing pursuant to Title 35A of the Revised Code of Washington, and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to require that all utility extensions be installed underground, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Utility Extensions Underground. Any person desiring to extend utilities in connection with any new construction within the City, shall install such utilities underground. The applicant shall be responsible for complying with the requirements of this section, and shall make all necessary arrangements with the utility companies and other persons or corporations affected by installation of such underground facilities. As used in this section, the term "utilities" includes, but is not limited to, public services provided in the form of electricity, telephone, and cable TV.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or

constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.
