ORDINANCE NO. 60

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING THE 1993 BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE NO. 22 TO REDUCE THE REVENUES TO THE STREET FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$202,000.00 AND REDUCING THE AMOUNT OF THE INTERFUND LOAN FROM THE STREET FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$102,000.00.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 22 on March 8, 1993 which approved a budget for the City of Woodinville for a nine month period between March 31 and December 31, 1993, and

WHEREAS, subsequent to passage of Ordinance No. 22, it was determined that the estimated revenues from the King County road tax would be \$202,000.00 less than anticipated, and

WHEREAS, in the original 1993 budget the City Council provided for an interfund loan between the street fund and the general fund, and

WHEREAS, because of the revenue shortfall, the interfund loan between the street fund and general fund must be reduced by \$102,000.00, and

WHEREAS, these adjustments to the 1993 budget could not reasonably have been anticipated at the time of passage of the budget, and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been on file with the City Clerk for more than five days before its consideration and passage,
NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 22, passed by the City Council on March 8, 1993, is hereby amended to read as follows:

General Fund	2,374,000
Street Fund	1,214,000
Arterial Street Fund	50,000
Capital Outlay Fund	159,000
Storm Water Utility Fund	562,900
Council Contingency	175,000
Equipment Rental Fund	<u>14,400</u>
Total Expenditures	<u>\$4,549,300</u>

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.




