ORDINANCE NO. 65

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 38 RELATING TO CREATING A MUNICIPAL COURT; AMENDING SECTION 1 TO SPECIFY THAT THE MUNICIPAL COURT SHALL COMMENCE OPERATIONS JANUARY 1, 1995; AMENDING SECTION 13(B) OF ORDINANCE NO. 38 TO PROVIDE FOR THE TERM OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT JUDGE; AMENDING SECTION 16 OF ORDINANCE NO. 38 TO ESTABLISH A NEW EFFECTIVE DATE; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council enacted Ordinance No. 38 on March 15, 1993, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 38 created a municipal court to be effective January 1, 1994, and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined to postpone the commencement of the municipal court to January 1, 1995, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 38 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Creation. The Municipal Court of the City of Woodinville is hereby created, which shall have jurisdiction and exercise all powers vested in the Court by Chapter 3.50 RCW as it now exists or may hereafter be amended, together with such other powers and jurisdiction as are generally conferred on such courts in Washington, either by common law or express statute. The Municipal Court shall commence operation January 1, 1995.

B. Term. The Municipal Court judge shall serve a term of four (4) years. The initial appointment of a judge under this ordinance, shall expire December 31, 1994. On or before December 1, 1994, the City Manager shall make an appointment of a judge for a term expiring December 31, 1998. Appointments for each term thereafter shall be made on or before December 1 of the year next preceding the year in which the judicial term commences.

Section 3. Section 16 of Ordinance No. 38 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Effective date. This ordinance shall be effective as of August 1, 1994, which is more than five (5) days after publication of an approved summary consisting of the title to this ordinance.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.


