

ORDINANCE NO. 85

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 55,
CREATING A PLANNING COMMISSION AND
PROVIDING FOR THE SELECTION OF PLANNING
COMMISSION MEMBERS.

WHEREAS, RCW 35A.63.020 authorizes creation of a Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 55 on May 10, 1993, which created a Planning Commission, provided for the selection and removal of Planning Commission members, and set forth their duties and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has reviewed Ordinance No. 55, and desires to amend Section 2, Membership, Paragraph B, Appointment, to reflect that appointees to the Planning Commission must reside within the city limits of the City of Woodinville, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON DO ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2, Membership, Paragraph B of Ordinance No. 55, which currently reads as follows:

"Section 2. Membership.

* * *

B. Appointment. Members of the Planning Commission shall be appointed by the City Council. Members of the Planning Commission must reside within the *City's planning area as set forth in the comprehensive plan. At least five members must reside within the City limits.* Planning Commission members shall be selected without respect to political affiliation and shall serve without compensation."

is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Membership.

* * *

B. Appointment. Members of the Planning Commission shall be appointed by the City Council. Members of the Planning Commission must reside within the


City limits. Planning Commission members shall be selected without respect to political affiliation and shall serve without compensation."

Section 2. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance, or a summary thereof, shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.
