ORDINANCE NO. 95

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMITS AND PARKING REGULATIONS, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 93, WHICH ESTABLISHED A MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC CODE FOR THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville has performed a speed survey in various locations throughout the City, and

WHEREAS, the City finds road surface characteristics, shoulder conditions, grade alignment, and sight distance such that maximum speed limits and no-parking zones must be established to provide safe conditions, and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that roadside development and culture, and roadside friction is such that maximum speed limit and no-parking zones must be established, and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that to provide a safe environment for pedestrians and bicyclists that large trucks on certain streets must be prohibited and that maximum speed limits and no-parking zones must be established, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Speed Limits. Section 16 of Woodinville Ordinance 93 is hereby amended to read as follows:

- A. Speed Limit 35 MPH. A speed limit of 35 miles per hour is hereby established for motor vehicle traffic on the following streets, roadways, highways and that no person shall operate a motor vehicle upon said streets, roads, or highways in excess of 35 miles per hour:
1. NE Woodinville - Duvall Rd. between 350 feet north of NE 179th Street and the East City Limits;
 2. 156th Ave. NE between NE Woodinville - Duvall Rd. and the North City Limits;
 3. Woodinville - Snohomish Rd. between 140th Ave. NE and the North City Limit;
 4. 130th Ave. NE, 130th PL NE, and 132nd Ave. NE between SR 522 and the North City Limit;

5. NE 171st Street, 146th PL. NE, and NE 173rd Street between 140th Ave. NE and NE 172nd Street (150th Ave. NE);
6. Woodinville Dr. between 127th PL. NE and the West City Limit;
7. 124th Ave. NE between the South City Limit and 730 feet north of NE 169th Street;
8. NE 143rd PL., 137th PL. NE and NE 145th Street between 132nd Ave. NE and SR 202;
9. NE 190th Street between Woodinville - Snohomish Road and NE North Woodinville Way;
10. NE 145th Street between 148th Ave. NE (SR 202) and the East City Limit;
11. 131st Ave. NE and NE 171st Street between NE 175th Street (SR 202) and 140th Ave. NE.
12. Woodinville - Redmond Road (SR 202) from 525 feet south of 127th PL. NE to SR 522
13. NE 177th Pl. and 139th Ave. NE between 131st Ave. NE (SR 202) and the Woodinville - Snohomish Rd.

B. Speed Limit 40 MPH. A speed limit of 40 miles per hour is hereby established for motor vehicle traffic upon the following streets, roadways, highways and that no person shall operate a motor vehicle upon said streets, roads, or highways in excess of 40 miles per hour:

1. NE 195th Street and NE North Woodinville Way between SR 522 and NE Woodinville - Duvall Rd.;
2. 148th Ave. NE between NE 145th Street (SR 202) and NE 147th PL.

C. Speed Limit 45 MPH. A speed limit of 45 miles per hour is hereby established for motor vehicle traffic upon the following streets, roadways, highways and that no person shall operate a motor vehicle upon said streets, roads, or highways in excess of 45 miles per hour:

1. Woodinville - Redmond Road (SR 202) between the South City Limit (NE 143rd Street) and 525 feet south of 127th PL. NE

D. The entry terminus of each street, roadway, highway, with a speed limit in excess of 25 miles per hour shall be posted with a sign clearly indicating the established legal speed limit. Advisory signs, indicating a reduced speed zone ahead, near the exit terminus of said street, roadway, highway, shall suffice as regulatory signs. Intersecting streets may be posted, where deemed advisable by the Traffic Engineer, with a sign indicating the legal speed limit on the intersecting streets, roadways, and highways. Intersections and curves may be posted with reduced speed limits where deemed advisable by the Traffic Engineer.

Except as provided above, no other signs or markings relating to speed shall be required on the affected streets, roadways, and highways, for the purposes of conformance and enforcement.

Section 2. Parking. Section 17 items 8, 11 and 13 of Woodinville Ordinance 93 are hereby amended and item 14 and 15 are added to read as follows:

8. 131st Pl. NE:
Between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3 p.m., Monday - Friday, except holidays; On the east and west sides: From NE 196th Pl. to 245 ft north of NE 197th Pl;

11. 144th Ave. NE:
On the east and west sides: From 350 feet south of NE 200th Street NE to NE 200th Street;
On the east side: From 550 feet north to 600 feet north of NE North Woodinville Way.

2 hour limit for vehicles and/or trailers in excess of 5 tons;
On the east and west sides: From NE North Woodinville Way to 350 feet south of NE 200th Street.

13. Woodinville - Snohomish Road (139th Ave. NE):
On the east side: From NE 195th Street to NE 200th Street.
On the west side: From 360 feet north of to 485 feet north of NE 195th Street.

14. NE 198th Court (cul-de-sac)
On the north, west, and south sides all lying west of 131st Pl. NE.

15. 139th Ave. NE
On the east side from NE 175th Street to 438 feet south of NE 175th Street.

Section 3. New Section. There is hereby created a new section, Section 21, with Sections 21 through 28 of Ordinance 93 renumbered sequentially, beginning with Section number 22. The new section 21 shall be titled and stated as follows:

Section 21. Prohibition of Trucks Exceeding 26,000 Pounds Gross Vehicle Weight Rated. Trucks exceeding 26,000 pounds gross vehicle weight rated shall be prohibited from traveling on the following streets except for local deliveries:

1. 156th Avenue NE: Between the North City Limits and the Woodinville-Duvall Road;

2. 124th Avenue NE/NE 173rd Place/127th Place NE: Between NE 160th Street and 782 feet north of NE 162nd Street, and between 200 feet north of 169th and Woodinville - Redmond Road (SR 202)

3. NE 143rd Street/137th Place NE/NE 145th Street from 132nd Avenue NE to Woodinville - Redmond Road (SR 202).

The offense of operating a truck exceeding 26,000 pounds gross vehicle weight rated on the above listed streets except for local deliveries shall be considered an infraction, punishable by a fine of not more than two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250).

Section 4. Severability. Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance, or a summary consisting of the title, shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.
