ORDINANCE NO. 106

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE 51, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE 94, RELATING TO BUSINESS LICENSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville entered into an interlocal agreement between King County and the City relating to regulatory licensing of certain businesses, and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville has researched the secondary effects of sexually oriented business; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville desires to regulate sexually oriented business, NOW, THEREFORE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. County Codes Adopted. Section 1 of Ordinance 51 as adopted on March 29, 1993 is amended as follows:


