ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 29,
WHICH REGULATES THE SALE, DISCHARGE AND
PUBLIC DISPLAY OF FIREWORKS

WHEREAS, Chapter 70.77 RCW authorizes the City to regulate the sale, discharge and public display of fireworks within the City, and

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it to be in the best interests of the public health, safety and welfare that fireworks be regulated, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Section 10 of Ordinance 29, which previously set an annual fee for a "seller's permit" at \$245, is hereby amended to set that fee at \$100.

Section 2. That part of Section 4 of Ordinance 29, which specifies as follows: "Applications shall be signed before a notary public by the retail seller, if an individual, or by a duly authorized officer, if an association or corporation" is hereby repealed.


Section 3. Effective Date This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after its passage and acceptance according to law.
