## ORDINANCE NO. 118

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 53, AND BY REFERENCE SECTION 14.04.250 OF THE WOODINVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE, ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL SEPA POLICIES.

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 53 establishes the City's procedures and policies under the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA);

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. 53 adopts Chapter 14.04, Environmental Protection;

**WHEREAS**, Section 14.04.250 adopts the City's Ordinances that are considered its "SEPA Policies";

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that additional ordinances should be adopted as SEPA Policies to protect the public health, safety, and general welfare of the City of Woodinville, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1.** Ordinance No. 53, Section 1, and by reference Section 14.04.250(B), is hereby amended as follows:






