ORDINANCE 119

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING A POWER OF INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM FOR THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodinville, Washington, passed Resolution No. 94 on March 27, 1995, stating its intent to adopt the powers of initiative and referendum for the qualified electors of the City as provided in RCW Chapter 35A.11, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Power of Initiative and Referendum Adopted

The City of Woodinville hereby adopts the power of initiative and referendum for the qualified electors of the City as pursuant to RCW 35A.11.080 through 35A.11.100. Such powers are to be exercised as provided in the above referenced sections of the Revised Code of Washington as they now exist or may be amended from time to time and said sections are hereby incorporated in full by this reference.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance will be in full force and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title which is approved by the City Council.
