**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, VACATING A PORTION OF
NORTHEAST 190TH STREET, AND PROVIDING AN
EASEMENT FOR PUBLIC UTILITIES AND SERVICES.**

WHEREAS, King County entered into an agreement for the exchange of a portion of right-of-way of NE 190th Street for the right-of-way for NE North Woodinville Way; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville did incorporate prior to King county fulfilling thier obligation of thier agreement for the exchange of rights-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the City Council did by Resolution No. 96, adopted on May 8th, 1995, set June 12, 1995 as the date for a public hearing on the proposed vacation; and

WHEREAS, the City's SEPA Responsible Official has determined previously that there will be no significant adverse environmental impacts as a result of the proposed vacation, and the City Council concurs in such determination, **NOW, THEREFORE,**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON DO
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The following described portion of right-of-way is hereby vacated, reserving to the City and its franchisees an easement for construction, reconstruction and maintenance of such reserved uses over that portion of the vacated right-of-way. Said right-of-way to be vacated is located within the City of Woodinville, Washington, and is described on Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as if set forth in full.

Section 2. The City Clerk/Treasurer is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this ordinance with the King County Department of Records and Elections.

Section 3. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.


Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title which is approved by the City Council.

The legal description of the vacation area is as follows:

That portion of the Southeast quarter of Section 3, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington described as follows:

All of Northeast 190th Street lying North of Lot 4 of KCSP 384062 Rev-8511140887 lying Southwesterly of the Southwest margin of the new Northeast 195th Street project (50 feet of right-of-way on each side of the centerline) and lying Easterly of the Northeast extension of the Northwest line of said Lot 4.

The vacation area contains approximately 11,850 square feet.
