## ORDINANCE NO. 134

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,  
WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE FIRE CODE,  
AMENDING SUBSECTIONS 12.2, 12.4.31.3, 12.4.31.4 OF  
ORDINANCE NO. 121.

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WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Washington directs cities to enforce the State Fire Code, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodinville adopted Ordinance No. 121, commonly known as the "Buildings and Construction Code" on June 26, 1995, which established local standards and regulations for enforcing the State Building and Fire Codes within the City, and

WHEREAS, the City finds that certain sections of Ordinance No. 121 require amendment based upon clerical errors and the need to clarify and update certain standards and regulations therein, and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the best interests of the public health, safety and general welfare to update and amend the Building and Construction Code,  
NOW, THEREFORE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON,  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Subsection 12.2 of Ordinance No. 121 is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.2 Adoption of codes. This Uniform Fire Code (UFC), 1994 Edition, including Appendix Chapters I-A, I-C, II-A, II-B, II-C, II-D, II-E, II-F, II-G, II-H, II-I, III-A, III-B, III-C, III-D, IV-A, IV-B, V-A, VI-A, and VI-B, VI-E, and the Uniform Fire Code Standards, 1994 Edition, published by the International Fire Code Institute and Copyright® by the International Conference of Building Officials and the Western Fire Chiefs' Association and as adopted and amended by the State of Washington pursuant to Chapters 51-34 and 51-35 Washington Administrative Code (WAC) are adopted by this reference as if set forth in full, subject to the amendments, additions, or deletions set forth. Provided, however, that the purpose of this code is not to create or otherwise establish or designate any particular class or group of persons who will or should be protected or benefited by the terms of this code. One copy of these uniform codes and regulations has been and is on file with the City Clerk for inspection.

Section 2. Subsection 12.4.31.3 of Ordinance No. 121, is hereby amended to

read as follows:

12.4.31 Fire Sprinkler Systems Shall be Installed:

\* \* \* \*

12.4.31.3 In all Group R, Division 1 occupancies having three or more floor levels or containing five or more dwelling units and hotels (motels) having three or more floor levels or containing ten or more guest rooms. Quick response standard sprinkler heads shall be used in accordance with their approved listing in the dwelling unit and guest room portions of the building. Area separation walls as noted in Section 504.6 of the Uniform Building Code shall not be considered to separate a building to enable deletion of the required fire sprinkler system.

Section 3. Subsection 12.4.31.4 of Ordinance No. 121 is hereby amended to read

as follows:

904.2.3.1 Drinking establishments. An automatic sprinkler system shall be installed in rooms used by the occupants for the consumption of alcoholic beverages and unseparated accessory uses where the total area of such unseparated rooms and assembly uses exceeds 5,000 square feet (465 m2). For uses to be considered as

separated, the separation shall not be less than as required for a one-hour occupancy separation. The area of other uses shall be included unless separated by at least a one-hour occupancy separation.

Section 4. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 5. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.
