

ORDINANCE NO. 137

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 105, WHICH ADOPTED A BUDGET FOR 1995.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 105, established certain funds, and estimated certain revenues and appropriations for all funds; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a grant to purchase the Jerry Wilmot Green Gateway Park; and

WHEREAS, the proceeds of the grant should be used to pay a portion of the principal outstanding; and

WHEREAS, the changes set forth herein could not reasonably have been anticipated at the time of adoption of the 1995 budget, and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been on file with the City Clerk more than 5 days prior to its passage; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The final budget for 1995 and Section 2 of Ordinance 77 are hereby amended as set forth herein. The totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for certain funds are amended as follows:


L.T.G.O. Line of Credit Note Fund, 1994	\$ 490,000
Capital Construction Fund	\$ 490,000

Section 2. Effective date. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Woodinville City Council and publication, as required by law.

Section 3. A copy of this Ordinance shall be transmitted to the Division of Municipal Corporations of the State Auditor and to the Association of Washington Cities.


