

**ORDINANCE NO. 161**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF  
WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING  
ORDINANCE NO. 138, ADOPTING THE 1996  
BUDGET TO ESTABLISH THE WILMOT PARK  
TRUST FUND.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council and the Jerry Wilmot Park Finance Committee have recommended that a fund be established to segregate contributions to the Wilmot Park; and

**WHEREAS**, trust and agency funds are appropriate funds for accounting for specific assets; and

**WHEREAS**, the Wilmot Park Trust Fund will receive public donations, and when needed for construction, transfer those dollars to the appropriate construction fund; and

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** There is hereby created the Wilmot Park Trust Fund, Fund 621, with estimated revenues and appropriations as set forth in Section 2.

**Section 2.** The budget for 1996 and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 138 are hereby amended as set forth herein. The totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for the Wilmot Trust Fund are as follows:




