

ORDINANCE NO. 162

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING THE PUBLIC RULE PROCESS FOR CREATION OF NO PARKING ZONES, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 93, WHICH ESTABLISHED A MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC CODE FOR THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE.

WHEREAS, the City finds road surface characteristics, shoulder conditions, grade alignment, and sight distance such that no-parking zones must be established to provide safe conditions, and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that roadside development and culture, and roadside friction is such that no-parking zones must be established, and

WHEREAS, the City has determined that to provide a safe environment for pedestrians and bicyclists that no-parking zones may be established by the Public Rule Process in accordance with Ordinance No. 159, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1. Parking.** Section 17 of Woodinville Ordinance No. 93 and Chapter 10.03.110 of the Woodinville Municipal Code are hereby amended to read as follows:


The traffic engineer shall have full authority to adopt administrative orders enacting parking restrictions on City streets which are in the best interests of the City and the public health, safety and welfare. Any and all such parking restrictions are hereby adopted by this reference and made a part hereof as if set forth fully herein. No such administrative orders shall become effective until posted as provided by Ordinance No. 159, *Adopting a Public Process for Change or Amendment of Administrative Rules; Establishing an Effective Date.*

**Section 2. Severability.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance, or its application to any person or circumstance, be declared unconstitutional or otherwise invalid for any reason, or should any portion of this ordinance be pre-empted by state or federal law or regulation, such decision or pre-emption shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance or its application to other persons or circumstances.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance, or a summary consisting of the title, shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after the date of publication.


