ORDINANCE NO. 176

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 9.03.130 OF THE WOODINVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE BY ADOPTING BY REFERENCE RCW 9A.36.150, THE STATE STATUTE WHICH ESTABLISHES THE CRIME OF INTERFERENCE WITH THE REPORTING OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE, AND FIXING A TIME WHEN THE SAME SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE.

WHEREAS, state legislature has made it a misdemeanor to interfere in the reporting of a domestic violence dispute in RCW 9A.36.150, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodinville wishes to adopt the state statute by reference, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON,
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 9.03.130 of the Woodinville Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.03.130 Crimes relating to persons.

The following state statutes, including all future amendments, additions or deletions are adopted by reference:

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction,

such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance, being an exercise of a power specifically delegated to the City legislative body, is not subject to referendum, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of an approved summary thereof consisting of the title.


