

ORDINANCE NO. 186

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 167, WHICH ADOPTED A BUDGET FOR 1997, TO ESTABLISH A NEW FUND, THE CIVIC CENTER RESERVE FUND, TO REVISE REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES TO FUND PROGRAMS THAT HAVE BEEN RECOMMENDED SINCE THE 1997 BUDGET WAS FORMALLY ADOPTED IN DECEMBER, 1996.

WHEREAS, the City Council has established the Civic Center as a priority for Woodinville,

WHEREAS, the City Council has identified certain sources for a down payment for a Civic Center,

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to set those funds aside for the purpose of providing a down payment for the civic center,

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 167 estimated certain revenues and appropriations for all funds; and

WHEREAS, certain other minor changes to the 1997 budget are appropriate to consider in amending the 1997 budget; and

WHEREAS, the changes set forth herein could not reasonably have been anticipated at the time of adoption of the 1997 budget; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been on file with the City Clerk more than 5 days prior to its passage; now, therefore

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new fund, the Civic Center Reserve Fund is hereby established with revenue and appropriations set forth in Section 2

Section 2. The revised budget for 1997 and Section 2 of Ordinance 138 are hereby amended as set forth herein. The totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for certain funds are amended with the revised total revenue and appropriations set forth as follows:


Real Property Reserve	\$ 1,700,000
Surface Water Management	\$ 1,539,700
Civic Center Reserve Fund	\$ 1,750,000

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance will be in full force and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title which is approved by the City Council.

Section 4. A copy of this Ordinance shall be transmitted to the Division of Municipal Corporations of the State Auditor and to the Association of Washington Cities.


