

ORDINANCE NO. 205

A ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, CHANGING THE NAME OF 138TH PLACE NE BETWEEN NE 175TH STREET AND NE 178TH PLACE TO GARDEN WAY NE; AND, CHANGING THE NAME OF NE 180TH PLACE BETWEEN NE 178TH PLACE AND 140TH AVENUE NE TO GARDEN WAY NE AND; CHANGING THE NAME OF NE 178TH PLACE BETWEEN WOODINVILLE-SNOHOMISH ROAD AND 140TH AVENUE NE TO NE MILL PLACE.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville desires to preserve connections to its history as a way of honoring the City's past and providing a perspective for its future; and

WHEREAS, the Woodinville Historical Society has researched the history of Woodinville and determined that names drawn from early Woodinville history and industries that provided a living for the early pioneers would be appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville has considered the request of citizens and the Historical Society and concluded that formally changing the name of the roadways would be appropriate:

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That portion of 138th Place NE between NE 175th Street and NE 178th Place is hereby renamed Garden Way NE.

Section 2. That portion of NE 180th Place between NE 178th Place and 140th Avenue NE is hereby renamed Garden Way NE.

Section 3. That portion of NE 178th Place between Woodinville-Snohomish Road and 140th Avenue NE is hereby renamed NE Mill Place.


Section 4. The City Manager is hereby directed to take all steps necessary and required to effect changing the name of these above-mentioned streets, including the installation of street

identification signs, notifying the U.S. Postal Service, King County, Target Inc., TRF-Pacific, and such other public and private entities as may be appropriate.

Section 5. This ordinance will be in full force and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title which is approved by the City Council.


