

ORDINANCE NO. 241

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 226, WHICH ADOPTED A BUDGET FOR 1999 AND ORDINANCE NO. 240, WHICH AMENDED THE 1999 BUDGET, TO ESTABLISH A CITY HALL CONSTRUCTION FUND, AND TO REVISE REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES TO ACCOUNT FOR GRANT REVENUE RECEIVED TO BE USED FOR A SPECIFIC SURFACE WATER CONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 226 estimated certain revenues and appropriations for all funds; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 240 acknowledged a larger than anticipated beginning balance, but no additional operating revenue for 1999; and

WHEREAS, the General Fund is forecast to have \$250,000 in operating revenue above previous estimates; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville has begun the preliminary design for a new City Hall; and

WHEREAS, additional sources of revenue are available from the existing General Fund budget;

WHEREAS, establishing a fund to monitor all costs associated with the construction is appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the Surface Water Fund received grant revenue of \$609,413 unanticipated in the 1999 budget for the construction work associated with the Hollywood Schoolhouse intersection; and

WHEREAS, grant revenue provided will be used for the payment of services received for the surface water improvements to the Hollywood Schoolhouse intersection; and

WHEREAS, the changes set forth herein could not have been reasonably anticipated at the time of adoption of the 1999 budget; and

WHEREAS, this ordinance has been on file with the City Clerk more than five (5) days prior to its passage; now, therefore

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO  
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** A new fund, the City Hall Construction Fund (Fund 380), is hereby established with revenue and appropriations as set forth in Section 2. The City Hall Construction Fund will be used to pay for all costs associated with the construction of a new City Hall.

**Section 2.** The revised budget for 1999 and Section 2 of Ordinance 226 are hereby amended as set forth herein. The totals of estimated revenues and appropriations for certain funds are amended with the revised total revenue and appropriations set forth as follows:

General Fund	\$10,390,789
City Hall Construction Fund	\$ 750,000
Surface Water Management	\$ 2,206,584

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance will be in full force and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title, which is approved by the City Council.


**Section 4.** A copy of the Ordinance shall be transmitted to the Division of Municipal Corporations of the State Auditor and to the Association of Washington Cities.


