

ORDINANCE NO. 277

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 245, WHICH ADOPTED A BUDGET FOR 2000 AND ORDINANCE NO. 265, WHICH AMENDED THE 2000 BUDGET, TO REVISE REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE ESTIMATES TO ACCOMMODATE THE PURCHASE OF REAL PROPERTY TO ABOLISH AN INACTIVE FUND, AND TO ACKNOWLEDGE OTHER HOUSEKEEPING DETAILS AS NECESSARY.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 245 estimated certain revenues and appropriations for all funds; and

WHEREAS, the Little Bear Creek Lineal Park Fund was established to purchase property along Little Bear Creek; and

WHEREAS, grant revenue has been applied for and granted for the purchase of habitat, using King Conservation monies; and

WHEREAS, real estate excise tax revenue that had been set aside for land purchasing in the 2001 budget is available for use in the 2000 budget; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Construction Fund was established to account for the revenue and expenditures associated with Wilmot Park and the Woodinville Valley; and

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville establishes separate funds for each capital project, and abolishes those funds upon completion; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Capital Construction Fund, a fund established by Ordinance No. 105, and used for various construction projects, is hereby abolished, with all residual equity to be transferred to the Little Bear Creek Lineal Park Fund.

Section 2. The revised budget for 2000 and Section 2 of Ordinance No. 245 are hereby amended as set forth herein. The totals of estimated revenues and

appropriations for certain funds are amended with the revised total revenue and appropriations set forth as follows:

Capital Construction Fund	\$ 111,926
Little Bear Creek Lineal Park	\$ 415,000

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance will be in full force and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title, which is approved by the City Council.

Section 4. A copy of the Ordinance shall be transmitted to the Division of Municipal Corporations of the State Auditor and to the Association of Washington Cities.
