

ORDINANCE NO. 313

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING THE CHARGES IMPOSED FOR THE USE OF THE STORM AND SURFACE WATER UTILITY TO BE SET BY RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville established a storm and surface water utility by the adoption of Ordinance No. 26 on March 8, 1993; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 26 also adopted the storm and surface water management fees that were established by King County; and

WHEREAS, the City Council would like to allow for these fees to be amended by resolution in the future; and

NOW, THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 26 of the City of Woodinville is hereby amended such that all fees charged by the City for the use of the storm and surface water utility will henceforth be established by resolution of the City Council. Aside from the fee provisions amended herein, the remainder of Ordinance No. 26 shall remain in full effect.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication; PROVIDED THAT the existing fees shall remain in effect until the City Council adopts a new surface water fee by resolution.


