

**ORDINANCE NO. 318**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 103 AND 140 TO ESTABLISH TERM LIMITS OF TWO CONSECUTIVE THREE-YEAR TERMS FOR TREE BOARD MEMBERS, ESTABLISHING A ONE YEAR INTERVAL IN SERVICE BEFORE ELIGIBILITY FOR REAPPOINTMENT TO THE TREE BOARD AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SEVERABILITY.**

**WHEREAS**, Woodinville Municipal Code Chapter 2.24/Tree Board authorized the creation of a Tree Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 103 on October 24, 1994, which created a Tree Board, provided for the selection of Tree Board members and set forth their duties and responsibilities; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to establish two (2) consecutive terms as a limit for all City Boards and Commissions; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to set a one year interval in service before eligibility for reappointment to the Tree Board:

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1. Amendments to Woodinville Municipal Code:**

Woodinville Municipal Code (herein referred to as WMC) 2.24.030/Term of Office which reads:

The term of the five persons to be appointed by the Mayor shall be three years except that the term of two of the members appointed to the first board shall be for only one year and the term of two members of the first board shall be for two years. In the event that a vacancy shall occur during the term of any member, his successor shall be appointed for the unexpired portion of the term.

is hereby amended to read as follows:

The term of the persons to be appointed by the Mayor shall be three years. Each member may be eligible to serve two (2) three-year consecutive terms, if reappointed. When two consecutive full terms have been served, there must be a one year interval in service before reappointments can be made to the Tree Board by the Mayor. In the event that a vacancy occurs during the terms of any member, his/her successor shall be appointed to serve for the unexpired portion of the term.

**Section 2. Severability.** If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.


