

ORDINANCE NO. 319

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 87 AND 169 TO ESTABLISH TERM LIMITS OF TWO CONSECUTIVE THREE-YEAR TERMS FOR THE PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION MEMBERS, ESTABLISHING A ONE YEAR INTERVAL IN SERVICE BEFORE ELIGIBILITY FOR REAPPOINTMENT TO THE PARKS & RECREATION COMMISSION AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, Woodinville Municipal Code Chapter 2.23/Parks and Recreation Commission authorized the creation of a Parks and Recreation Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 87 on September 9, 1996, which created a Parks & Recreation Commission, provided for the selection and removal of Parks & Recreation Commissioners and set forth their duties and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 169 on December 9, 1996 which expanded membership of the Parks & Recreation Commission from five to seven members; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish two (2) consecutive terms as a limit for all City Boards and Commissions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has set a one year interval in service before eligibility for reappointment to the Parks & Recreation Commission:

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendments to the Woodinville Municipal Code

Woodinville Municipal Code (herein referred to as WMC) 2.23.020/Membership which reads:

- (1) Number of Members. The Parks and Recreation Commission shall consist of seven members, each of whom shall be appointed for a term of three years; provided, however, the first appointments to the Parks and Recreation Commission shall consist of three individuals appointed for terms

of two years and four individuals appointed for terms of three years. Subsequent appointments shall be for three-year terms. Terms shall expire on December 31st.

is hereby amended to read as follows:

The Parks and Recreation Commission shall consist of seven members, each of whom shall be appointed for a term of three years. When two consecutive full terms have been served, members may be eligible to serve two (2) three-year consecutive terms, if reappointed. There must be a one year interval in service before reappointments can be made to the Parks & Recreation Commission. Terms shall expire on December 31st.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.
