

ORDINANCE NO. 320

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NOS. 55, 85 AND 184, ESTABLISHING A ONE YEAR INTERVAL IN SERVICE BEFORE ELIGIBILITY FOR REAPPOINTMENT TO THE PLANNING COMMISSION AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SEVERABILITY.

WHEREAS, Woodinville Municipal Code Chapter 2.12/Planning Commission authorized the creation of a Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 55 on May 10, 1993, which created a Planning Commission, provided for the selection and removal of Planning Commissioners and set forth their duties and responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 85 on April 11, 1994 which changed the membership requirement for the Planning Commissioners, making it mandatory they reside in City limits while serving; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish two (2) consecutive terms as a limit for all City Boards and Commissions; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has set a one year interval in service before eligibility for reappointment to the Planning Commission:

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendments to the Woodinville Municipal Code

Woodinville Municipal Code (herein referred to as WMC) 2.12.020/Membership which reads:

(1) Number of Members. The Planning Commission shall consist of seven members, each of whom shall be appointed for a term of four years; provided, however, the first appointments to the Planning Commission shall consist of three individuals appointed for terms of two years and four individuals appointed for terms of four years. Subsequent appointments shall be for four year terms, and beginning in 1997 two Commission positions are extended for one year, terminating in July 1998, one Commission position is extended one year (from 1999 to 2000), two new Commission positions are filled, to

terminate in 2001, and two Commission positions terminate in 1999, thus limiting the yearly changes of personnel to two Commissioners each year except one on one year. Planning Commissioners may serve up to two consecutive four year terms, with re-application possible only after a time of nonservice.

is hereby amended to read as follows:


The Planning Commission shall consist of seven members, each of whom shall be appointed for a term of four years. When two consecutive full terms have been served, members may be eligible to serve two (2) four-year consecutive terms, if reappointed. There must be a one year interval in service before reappointments can be made to the Planning Commission. Terms shall expire on July 1st.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.


