

**ORDINANCE NO. 349**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,  
WASHINGTON, WASHINGTON, DIRECTING A ONE-  
TIME EXCEPTION FOR THE USE OF ADMISSION  
TAX REVENUE PURSUANT TO WMC 3.10.060.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Woodinville has determined that an amendment exception to the Admission Tax revenue uses are necessary to allocate funding toward the Greenbrier Community Center improvements, and

**WHEREAS**, the amendment exception is necessary to make a private/public partnership possible; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 13, 2003, the City Council reviewed the proposal; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council determines that the Amendment exception and the resulting use of the facility will assist in meeting park, recreation, and open space needs in the Greenbrier community and within the City;


**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON,  
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** A one-time exception to the uses for Admission Tax revenue is hereby directed to allow for Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) of Admission Tax funds revenue to be expended through the Housing Trust Fund for the Greenbrier Community Center improvements pursuant to a funding agreement, promissory note, and memorandum of agreement to be executed between the City of Woodinville and Downtown Action to Save Housing (DASH).

**Section 2.** Effective date. This ordinance shall be effective five (5) days after publication of an approved summary consisting of the title of this ordinance.


