

ORDINANCE NO. 458

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, CONCERNING THE SALARIES FOR MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 192 AND ADDING NEW WMC SECTION 2.06.020; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Woodinville Municipal Code Section 2.060.010 establishes the salaries to be paid to Woodinville City Councilmembers; and

WHEREAS, Councilmembers may wish to decline or waive the salary established by ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Addition of New Code Section. Woodinville Municipal Code is hereby amended by the addition of new section 2.06.020, which section shall read as follows:

"2.06.020 Councilmember waiver and election not to receive compensation.

A councilmember may voluntarily waive and elect not to be paid all or any portion of the salaries set forth in WMC 2.06.010 during their term of office. Notice of waiver and election must be:

- A. In writing and delivered to the finance director prior to the effective date;
- B. Signed by the Councilmember and their spouse, if married, as required by RCW 49.48.100. Signature(s) shall be before a notary public.

The waiver shall be effective for all salary earned following the effective date and continue in effect until withdrawn by a writing signed by the Councilmember or their spouse delivered to the Finance Director. Councilmember's salaries that are declined or waived shall be used for the human services grant program.

Section 2. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof shall be published in the City's official newspaper, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and the publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title.


Section 3. Severability. If any sentence, clause, phrase or provision of this ordinance is ultimately invalidated by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidation shall not effect any other sentence, clause, phrase or provision hereof.


