

ORDINANCE NO. 468

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AMENDING WOODINVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE 10.12.030(3)(F) REGARDING THE HEIGHT OF THE FIRE LANE SIGNS, PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Woodinville Municipal Code 10.12.030(3)(f) establishes that the top of a Fire Lane sign shall be not less than four feet nor more than six feet from the ground; and

WHEREAS, Woodinville's Transportation and Infrastructure Standards and Specifications, requires the height of Fire Lane signs to be a minimum height of 7 feet; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to amend WMC 10.12.030 (3)(f) to avoid conflicting regulations for Fire Lane Signs;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Amendment of WMC 10.12.030. Subsection 10.12.030(3)(f) of the Woodinville Municipal Code is hereby amended to provide in its entirety as follows:


10.12.030(3)(f)

“(f) Placed at a height that conforms with the City of Woodinville's Transportation and Infrastructure Standards and Specifications, as they may be adopted or amended from time to time;”

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.
