

ORDINANCE NO. 486

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 269, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 329, TO ABOLISH THE ADVANCE TRAVEL FUND.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 269 established the Advance Travel Revolving Fund to assist with the payment of travel expenses of employees and officials of the City; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 329 decreased the amount in the Advance Travel Revolving Fund from \$5,000 to \$2,000; and

WHEREAS, the Advance Travel Revolving Fund is no longer used by employees or officials of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Abolishment of Advance Travel Revolving Fund. The Advance Travel Revolving Fund is hereby abolished and Ordinances No. 269 and 329 are hereby repealed.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, sentence, clause or phase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.


Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.


