

## ORDINANCE NO. 501

### **AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON AMENDING WOODINVILLE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.06.020 CONCERNING THE USE OF WAIVED OR DECLINED SALARIES FOR MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL.**

**WHEREAS**, Woodinville Municipal Code Section (WMC) 2.060.010 establishes the salaries to be paid to Woodinville City Councilmembers; and

**WHEREAS**, Councilmembers may waive or decline their salary pursuant to the process established in WMC 2.06.02;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that salaries waived under the provisions of Section 2.06.020 should be used for General Fund purposes;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 2.06.020, shall be amended in its entirety as follows:

**“2.06.020 Councilmember waiver and election not to receive compensation.**

A councilmember may voluntarily waive and elect not to be paid all or any portion of the salaries set forth in WMC 2.06.010 during their term of office. Notice of waiver and election must be:

- A. In writing and delivered to the finance director prior to the effective date;
- B. Signed by the Councilmember and their spouse, if married, as required by RCW 49.48.100. Signature(s) shall be before a notary public.

The waiver shall be effective for all salary earned following the effective date and continue in effect until withdrawn by a writing signed by the Councilmember or their spouse delivered to the Finance Director. Councilmember’s salaries that are declined or waived shall be used for any General Fund purpose.”

**Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance or a summary thereof shall be published in the City's official newspaper, and shall take effect five (5) days after passage and the publication of the ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the title.

**Section 3. Severability.** If any sentence, clause, phrase or provision of this ordinance is ultimately invalidated by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidation shall not effect any other sentence, clause, phrase or provision hereof.
