

**ORDINANCE NO. 522**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DESIGNATING OFFICIAL POSTING PLACES FOR WHICH NOTICES AND PUBLICATIONS FOR WHICH NOTICE IS REQUIRED TO BE GIVEN TO THE PUBLIC AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Woodinville is required to establish a procedure for notifying the public of upcoming hearings and the preliminary agenda for the forthcoming council meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, such procedure may include, but not be limited to, written notification to the city's official newspaper, publication of a notice in the official newspaper, posting of upcoming council meeting agendas, or such other processes as the city determines will satisfy the intent of this requirement;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The following public places in the city are designated as the official posting places for all city notices and other documents required by law to be posted under RCW 35A.12.160:

- A. Woodinville City Hall, 17301 133<sup>rd</sup> Avenue NE, Woodinville, WA; Bulletin Board located on the exterior wall of the City Council Chambers by the main City Hall Entrance; and
- B. United States Post Office, 17610 Woodinville Snohomish Rd NE, Woodinville, WA; Bulletin Board located on the exterior wall by the Main Entrance.

Section 2. Whenever possible the city shall utilize additional forms of notice including, but not limited to, the City of Woodinville official website.

Section 3. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.


