

**ORDINANCE NO. 612**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON NE 195<sup>th</sup> STREET BETWEEN 163<sup>RD</sup> COURT NE AND 164<sup>TH</sup> AVENUE NE BY AMENDING SECTION 10.03.110 WMC; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND SUMMARY PUBLICATION BY ORDINANCE TITLE ONLY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Woodinville, shortly after incorporation in 1994, adopted City of Woodinville Ordinance No. 88, establishing parking restrictions on certain streets with the corporate limits of the city; and

**WHEREAS**, since 1994 the City Council of Woodinville has adopted Ordinances No. 93, 95, 297, 460, and 583, adding to the number of streets that have parking restrictions on them and making other revisions; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has received complaints and concerns relating to the safety of allowing vehicles to park along the sides of the street described herein, and the City Council requested staff to further investigate and make recommendation to the City Council; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Director and the Chief of Police, upon inspection of the road, and after reviewing the roadway geometry, proximity of the existing gate across NE 195<sup>th</sup> Street to this section of road, the needs for emergency vehicle access and circulation, traffic volumes, and adjoining property uses, recommend that parking not be allowed on both sides of NE 195<sup>th</sup> Street between 163<sup>rd</sup> Court NE and 164<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** **Section 10.03.110** of the Woodinville Municipal Code ("WMC") is hereby amended to prohibit parking on the portion of street described below by adding the following new subsection:

(19) NE 195<sup>th</sup> Street both sides, from the west side of 163<sup>rd</sup> Court NE (a private road) to the east side of 164<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE.

All other provisions of Section 10.03.110 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

**Section 2. Severability.** Should any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance be held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance.

**Section 3. Effective Date.** This ordinance or a summary thereof consisting of the ordinance title shall be published in the official newspaper of the City, and shall take effect and be in full force five (5) days after publication.
