RESOLUTION NO. 43

A RESOLUTION authorizing submission of an application to King County Parks Division, Office of Open Space, for 1993 Regional Conservation Future Acquisition Program for Suburban Cities funding for park acquisition.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville was recently incorporated on March 31, 1993; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted a park and open space element of the City of Woodinville Interim Comprehensive Plan listing acquisition of a park as a high priority; and

WHEREAS, there are no municipal parks in the City of Woodinville and the City Council desires to proceed with acquisition of a passive use park to encourage use of the Sammamish River "as a trail corridor and fishing area" as stated in Park Policy 15, Chapter 8 of said Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, property for the site is currently available for purchase and may be lost to commercial development if acquisition is delayed; and

WHEREAS, the property will be included in the Parks and Open Space element of the Washington State Growth Management Act (GMA) mandated Comprehensive Plan for the City of Woodinville when adopted; and


WHEREAS, the property is a high priority acquisition for the reasons stated above,
