A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING AN ADOPT-A-STREET
PROGRAM TO ALLOW VOLUNTEERS TO ASSIST IN THE
CLEAN-UP OF CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY.

WHEREAS, the City of Woodinville recognizes the value of clean and beautiful City streets; and


WHEREAS, a litter-free city streetscape has the effect of increasing civic responsibility and pride, and enhancing the economic vitality of a community; and

WHEREAS, volunteer groups are able to give of their time and energy, demonstrate commitment to a clean environment, and discourage would-be litterbugs by keeping sections of streets litter-free; **NOW THEREFORE**,

DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. An Adopt-A-Street Program is hereby established, to be administered according to the guidelines established in Chapter 47.40, RCW.
