RESOLUTION NO. 80

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, RECOMMENDING A BAIL SCHEDULE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE SUPREME COURT AND SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 6006, THE JUDICIAL INFORMATION SYSTEM FUNDING BILL.

WHEREAS, the 1994 legislature recently enacted Substitute Senate Bill 6006, the Judicial Information System (JIS) Funding Bill, effective March 21, 1994, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this bill was to adequately fund the JIS and other computing needs of the courts by dedicating ten dollars (\$10.00) from every traffic and civil infraction penalty collected and placing it into a JIS account, and

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has retained jurisdiction over bail schedules for certain common state infractions and set a bail schedule for the same which is contained in the Infraction Rules for Local Jurisdiction (IRLJ) 6.2, which increased the base penalty of most state infractions to cover the \$10.00 fee to the JIS account, and

WHEREAS, bail schedules for certain city infractions unique to the City of Woodinville need to be increased in order to cover the \$10.00 fee to the JIS account, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodinville wishes to recommend to Northeast District Court the following updated bail schedule, which shall include the \$10.00 increased

fee, with the understanding that the court has the ultimate authority in setting bail schedules, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Woodinville Traffic Ordinance - Recommended Bail Schedule. The City Council of the City of Woodinville recommends the following bail schedule to Northeast District Court:




