

RESOLUTION NO. 85

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING A FEE FOR TEMPORARY USE PERMIT FOR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, AND AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 79, SETTING CERTAIN FEES..

WHEREAS, Resolutions 71 and 79 amend Resolution No. 52, which establishes fees for fire permits, land use application fees, right-of-way and development fees; and

WHEREAS, the fee required for the issuance of a temporary use permit is set at \$100 for single families, and \$2,000 for all others, in Attachment B to Resolution No. 79; and

WHEREAS, it may be unduly burdensome to require nonprofit organizations to pay a \$2,000 fee for the issuance of a temporary use permit, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. A new Attachment B, Land Use Application Schedule, setting a fee in the amount of \$50.00 for the issuance of a temporary use permit to nonprofit organizations is hereby established, and shall be effective on the date of Council adoption.

Section 2. Nonprofit organizations requesting a temporary use permit will be required to provide proof of their nonprofit status at the time the temporary use permit is applied for.



A general use permit shall be required for any activity, operation or location not specifically described below which, in the judgment of the Woodinville Fire and Life Safety District Fire Marshal, is likely to produce conditions hazardous to life or property. Provided that no permit or fee shall be required for the use of candles in ceremonies by non-profit organizations.

*CF: **Consultant Fees.** In addition to the application fee, the applicant shall reimburse the City for the costs of professional consultants hired by the City review and inspect the applicant's proposal when the City is unable to do so with existing City staff. These professional services may include, but shall not be limited to, engineering, traffic engineering, legal, planning, Hearing Examiner, environmental review, financial and accounting, soils, mechanical and structural engineering, and electrical engineering. The City may require the applicant to deposit an amount with the City to cover anticipated costs of retaining professional consultants.

SF: **Single-Family Residential.** Single-family residential application fee applies to applications which meet the following criteria:

- (a) The proposed type of action will not change the existing and/or proposed single-family or duplex use of the property; and
- (b) The property is zoned RA, R-1, R-4, R-6, or R-8, and developed with a single-family or duplex residence; or
- (c) The property includes a single-family residential dwelling or duplexes; or
- (d) A building permit for a single-family residence has been applied for on the property.
