## RESOLUTION NO. 88

### A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, SUPPORTING AN INCENTIVE BASED RATE STRUCTURE FOR SOLID WASTE SERVICES

**WHEREAS**, the City of Woodinville intends to become a leader in providing recycling opportunities for its citizens through its waste reduction and recycling programs, and

**WHEREAS**, it is the goal of the City to limit its impact on the environment by reducing the quantity and toxicity of City generated wastes, and

**WHEREAS**, The City of Woodinville has adopted the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan calling for a 65% waste reduction and recycling goal by the year 2000, NOW, THEREFORE,

### **THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1.** Whenever certificated haulers file tariffs with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, an incentive based solid waste collection rate structure shall be used. An incentive based solid waste collection rate structure is one that rewards customers who recycle and includes substantial cost differentials between solid waste collection service levels. The tariffs filed shall include the following percentages of increases between levels of service: a minimum of sixty percent between mini and one can; a minimum of forty percent between one and two cans or equivalent; and a minimum of twenty five percent between two and three cans or equivalent. These percentages should apply to the combined charge to the customer for both solid waste and recyclable materials collection. The WUTC is strongly encouraged to approve tariffs that are consistent with the policies set forth in this chapter and that meet the minimum percentages specified in this section.

**Section 2.** In the event that the City of Woodinville adopts a service level ordinance, franchise agreement, or contract for the collection of household garbage and/or recyclables, these rate incentive differentials will be incorporated into said ordinance, agreement or contract and;

~~**Section 3.** A copy of this resolution will be forwarded to Waste Management-Sno-King and the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission upon its adoption by the Council of the City of Woodinville.~~
