RESOLUTION NO. 90

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE ADOPTING THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 38.52, requiring cities to provide for an emergency management organization, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 40, Authorizing Appointment of a Director of Emergency Services, Specifying the Duties of the Director and Establishing an Effective Date of March 15, 1995; and


WHEREAS, on February 14, 1994, the City Council authorized the City Manager to enter into a contract with consultant Charles Wittenberg for the Development of an Emergency Management Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Consultant has worked closely with City staff, representatives of the King County Police and members of Woodinville Fire & Life Safety to develop an Emergency Operations Plan to guide City operations and assist residents in the event of a disaster, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

To adopt the Emergency Operations Plan, a copy of which has been given Clerk's Receiving No. 262.
