## RESOLUTION NO. 96

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, SETTING A HEARING DATE TO CONSIDER VACATION OF A PORTION OF NE 190TH STREET

WHEREAS, a petition signed by the owners of more than two thirds of the property abutting upon property dedicated for street purposes, located in the City of Woodinville, Washington, being a portion of NE 190th Street, and more particularly described on Exhibit "A", attached hereto, and incorporated in full by this reference, was filed with the City Clerk/Treasurer of the City for the vacation of the above described property and who has returned a certification of sufficiency; and

WHEREAS, state law in RCW 35.79 requires a hearing on such petition and that the date of such hearing must be fixed by resolution of the City Council, NOW, THEREFORE,

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The time and place for the hearing and determination by the City Council of said petition is fixed as 7:00 p.m. on June 12, 1995, at the Council Chambers, 13203 NE 175th Street, Woodinville, Washington.

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## EXHIBIT A

The legal description of the vacation area is as follows:

That portion of the Southeast quarter of Section 3, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M., King County, Washington described as follows:

All of Northeast 190th Street lying North of Lot 4 of KCSP 384062 Rev-8511140887 lying Southwesterly of the Southwest margin of the new Northeast 195th Street project (50 feet of right-of-way on each side of the centerline) and lying Easterly of the Northeast extension of the Northwest line of said Lot 4.

The vacation area contains approximately 11,850 square feet.
