

**RESOLUTION NO. 110**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,  
WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING APPLICATION(S)  
FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR THE  
SAMMAMISH RIVER PROJECT THROUGH AN  
AQUATIC LANDS ENHANCEMENT ACCOUNT TO  
THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.**

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of Chapter 79.24.580, RCW, state funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land and the construction of facilities for public access to, and aquatic land enhancement of, state-owned aquatic lands; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Woodinville considers it in the best public interest to develop a waterfront park located on the Sammamish River; and

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,  
WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the City Manager may be authorized to make formal application to the Department of Natural Resources for funding assistance.

**Section 2.** That any fund assistance so received be used for the development of three and seven tenths (3.7) acres on the Sammamish River within the City of Woodinville.

**Section 3.** That the City's share of project funding will be derived from private donations, and City funds.

**Section 4.** That any property acquired or developed with financial aid through the Aquatic Lands Enhancement Account be placed in use in accordance with the terms of the financial aid approved by the Department of Natural Resources.

**Section 5.** That this resolution become part of the formal application to the Department of Natural Resources.

**Section 7.** That adequate notification has been given and the opportunity provided for public input.
