

RESOLUTION NO. 116

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE 120 DAY PERMIT
PROCESSING TIME LIMIT AS SET FORTH IN
ORDINANCE NO. 143, AS THE MAXIMUM TIME
STANDARD FOR PROCESSING ALL LAND
DEVELOPMENT APPLICATIONS**

WHEREAS, the State of Washington did enact ESHB 1724 in July, 1995, requiring cities to complete the review process of certain land use permit applications within 120 days; and


WHEREAS, the City Council did adopt Ordinance No. 143 establishing Woodinville Municipal Code (WMC) Chapters 17.07 through 17.17 for permit processing, in compliance with the requirements of ESHB 1724, on March 28, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the City Council believes it is important to have a consistent standard for review of all land development permit applications received by the City; now, therefore,

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON
RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The maximum 120 days for review stipulated by Ordinance No. 143 for land use applications requiring a SEPA review shall be the standard 120 days maximum amount of time allowed for processing all land development applications received by the City of Woodinville except those exempted in WMC 17.07.050A and 17.07.070A.
