

RESOLUTION NO. 117

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE,
WASHINGTON, AMENDING RESOLUTIONS 79 AND 95,
SETTING CERTAIN FEES.**

WHEREAS, the Woodinville Fire & Life Safety District has evaluated the costs of providing certain services; and

WHEREAS, the Woodinville Fire & Life Safety District has determined that certain fees should be amended to reflect the actual cost of services, and

WHEREAS, the fees as shown in Attachments A and E hereto reflect the actual fees for certain services, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A new Attachment A, Woodinville Fire & Life Safety Uniform Fire Code Permit Fees, is hereby established and shall be effective on the date of Council adoption.

Section 2. A new Attachment E, Woodinville Fire & Life Safety Plan Check fees, is hereby established and shall be effective on the date of Council adoption.
