

RESOLUTION NO. 124

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, RECOMMENDING A BAIL SCHEDULE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATE SUPREME COURT AND SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 6006, THE JUDICIAL INFORMATION SYSTEM FUNDING BILL, AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 80.

WHEREAS, the Supreme Court has retained jurisdiction over bail schedules for certain common state infractions and set a bail schedule for the same which is contained in the Infraction Rules for Local Jurisdiction (IRLJ) 6.2, and

WHEREAS, bail schedules for certain city infractions unique to the City of Woodinville have not been amended or updated since 1994, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Woodinville wishes to recommend to Northeast District Court the following updated bail schedule, with the understanding that the court has the ultimate authority in setting bail schedules, NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recommended Bail Schedule. The City Council of the City of Woodinville recommends the following bail schedule to Northeast District Court:
