RESOLUTION NO. 146

A Resolution establishing July 4, 1998 Tow Away zones along certain streets to facilitate safety for the July 4, 1998 celebration including the fireworks display.

WHEREAS, the July 4 Festival including Fireworks attracts many attendees, and

WHEREAS, parking prohibition violators endanger vehicle and pedestrian traffic, and

WHEREAS, Tow Away zones with Tow Away signing will provide for immediate removal of vehicles violating the parking prohibitions, **NOW THEREFORE,**

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Woodinville-Redmond Rd (SR202), NE 145 St, NE 148 St, 148 Ave NE, NE 143 St, 137 Pl NE, and segments of other streets identified on the attached exhibit A will be posted with "No parking, standing or stopping: TOW AWAY ZONE July 4" signs.

Section 2. IMPOUND AUTHORIZED. Any vehicle parking, stopping, or standing on Woodinville-Redmond Rd (SR202), NE 145 St, 148 Ave NE, NE 143 St, 137 Pl NE, and segments of other streets identified on the attached exhibit A on July 4, 1998 is hereby declared a traffic safety hazard and will be subject to being immediately towed away at the registered owner's expense.

Section 3. Notice. The City's Traffic Engineer is hereby directed to post the appropriate signs giving notice of the parking restrictions imposed by this Resolution.

Section 4. Future Events. In the event of future fireworks displays by the City, the Traffic Engineer is hereby directed to adopt the appropriate parking restrictions on City streets pursuant to WMC Section 10.03.110.


