**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE
PROTECTING THE MAXIMUM FUTURE LEVY CAPACITY**

WHEREAS the City of Woodinville has adopted a Capital Improvement Plan that identifies projects for the next six years: and

WHEREAS the City has identified projects in the adopted C.I.P. that have no source of funding at this time, and

WHEREAS the City of Woodinville would like to protect future levy capacity by maximum allowable;

NOW THEREFORE THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. The City Council has found that there is substantial need to preserve the maximum levy, and has adopted this resolution by a super majority vote of the Council.
