

**RESOLUTION NO. 189**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF  
WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, SETTING  
A PUBLIC HEARING DATE TO CONSIDER  
VACATION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY ON  
133<sup>rd</sup> AVENUE NE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City has identified 133<sup>rd</sup> Avenue NE as a Grid Road, connecting NE 171<sup>st</sup> Street through to NE 175<sup>th</sup> Street; and

**WHEREAS**, a section of the current right-of-way does not allow for the construction of a roadway that could meet existing industry standards in road design, which is shown on Exhibit A; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the opinion of the City Engineer that the new road alignment will serve the same function as the existing right-of-way with no net gain or loss to the public; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Woodinville City Council has itself initiated this vacation per Woodinville Municipal Code Chapter 12.18.030; and

**WHEREAS**, RCW 35.79 requires a public hearing on such a petition and that the date of such public hearing must be fixed by Resolution of the City Council; **NOW, THEREFORE**,

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON,  
DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

The time and place for the public hearing and determination by the City Council of said petition is fixed as 8:00 p.m. on 12 March 2001, in the Council Chambers located at 17301 133<sup>rd</sup> Avenue NE, Woodinville, Washington.
