

## RESOLUTION NO. 199

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR LITTLE BEAR CREEK LINEAL PARK, A WASHINGTON WILDLIFE AND RECREATION PROGRAM (WWRP) PROJECT, TO THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION (IAC) AS PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 79A.15 RCW, ACQUISITION OF HABITAT CONSERVATION AND OUTDOOR RECREATION LANDS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Woodinville has approved a Parks Recreation and Open Space Plan that includes the Little Bear Creek Lineal Park; and

**WHEREAS**, under the provisions of WWRP, state funding assistance is requested to aid in financing the cost of land acquisition and/or facility development; and

**WHEREAS**, our organization considers it in the best public interest to complete the land acquisition project described in the application;

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODINVILLE, WASHINGTON, DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** That the City Manager be authorized to make formal application to IAC for funding assistance;

**Section 2.** That any funding assistance be used for implementation of the project referenced above;

**Section 3.** That the City hereby certifies that its share of project funding is committed and will be derived from the revenues of the City;

**Section 4.** That we acknowledge that we are responsible for supporting all non-cash commitments to the sponsor share should they not materialize;

**Section 5.** That we acknowledge that any property acquired or facility developed with IAC financial aid must be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless otherwise provided and agreed to by our organization and IAC;

**Section 6.** That this resolution becomes part of a formal application to IAC; and

**Section 7.** That adequate notification has been given and the opportunity provided for public input and that published notices have identified affected flood plains and/or wetlands, if applicable.
